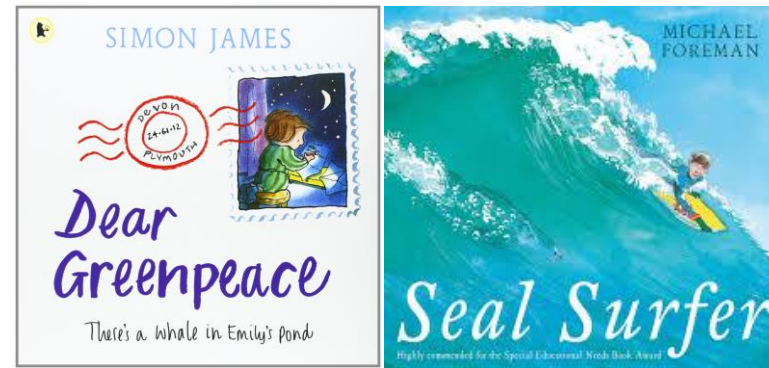


All at Sea



English

In Reciprocal Reading we are reading 'Dear Greenpeace' by Simon James and 'Seal Surfer' by Michael Foreman. We will write stories, letters, poems and information texts inspired by the sea.

SATs

Although SAT tests are now complete, we are continuing to gather information to support our teacher assessment judgements. We will provide End of Key Stage judgements in your child's Record of Achievement.

Maths

We will continue to use Inspire Maths to teach the core maths curriculum but will also use the theme to enhance this. We will think about position and direction, linked to the whales ability to navigate. We will measure liquids and solids to create water which is salty like the sea. We will find out the size of different sea creatures and draw them life size by measuring them on the playground. We will link money work with pirate treasure.

RE/PSHE

We will learn about how important water is in different religions and read stories from different cultures which focus on water. We will learn about being global citizens, thinking about how important water is to sustain life and consider communities over the world where there is not easy access to clean drinking water.

Science

We will learn the different plants and animals which make the seaside their habitat. We will consider how they differ from animals and plants local to Maltby. We will find out about rocks and the fossils which are found on our coastline.
