What was the impact of the second World War?

SATs Week

Monday 13th May – Thursday 16th May 2024



English

This half term we producing some non-fiction writing linking to the Home Front during WW2. We will also be writing formal letters linking to our learning about evacuation during WW2. Towards the end of the half term we are going to produce persuasive writing in the form of a holiday brochure and then a letter of complaint Tripadvisor style!

History

This half term we will continue with our WW2 topic and focus on the following key questions: What was the impact of the Blitz in Britain? Why did Dunkirk evacuation happen? Why is it so difficult to be sure about what life on the home front was really like? What was the role of women during the war? What was VE day really like? In what ways did Britain change after WW2?

Maths

In maths over the next 4 weeks before SATs we will be revising concepts and particularly focussing on reasoning questions to support the children applying their maths skills to the worded style questions.

Spanish

Spanish will continue to be taught by MA and focusses on preparing the children for Y7.

Computing

In computing we will be learning how to create our own animations inspired by the scenes witnessed in the London Blitz.

PE

PE days for Year 6: Monday and Wednesday.

Basketball and Team Building (first two weeks of Summer 1) then we will be moving onto Orienteering and Cricket for the remaining weeks.

Science

In Science we will finish studying the topic of Light.

Art

In Art this half term our artist focus will be Henry Moore – sculptor and painter. We will analyse his artwork that represents the London Underground stations during the WW2 air-raid and produce our own pieces of artwork in the same style.

PHSE

In PHSE, the children will continuing to studying the topic 'Growing Up Responsibilities' which includes looking at digital footprint and keeping safe online. There will be a mental health focus.

RE

In RE this half term the children will be studying the topic: What will make our town more respectful?
