Year 3 – Summer 1 and 2 How did the colliery change Maltby?



English

In English this half term, we will be reading Canary in the Coal Mines by Madelyn Rosenberg. We will be writing interviews, poetry and newspaper reports, as well as reading newspaper reports regarding Maltby Main Colliery.

Geography/History

In Geography, we will be using fieldwork to observe, measure and record some of the human and physical features in the local area using sketch maps and graphs. We will conduct surveys and carry out a simple questionnaire. We will use simple equipment to measure and record. We will be investigating the local area, looking at types of shops, services and houses. In History, we will be using our skills to determine why Maltby has changed over time. We will be enquiring what causes and effects this had on the area. We will be using Primary and Secondary sources to investigate this period of time.

Maths

In Maths this half term, we will be delving further into fractions, including adding and subtracting, finding equivalent fractions and fractions of amounts.

Linked to our Science learning, Year 3 will be designing and making a piece of reflective clothing.

Computing

Pupils will being creating podcasts about how we can keep ourselves safe online.
