**Y4 Visit to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park**  
**Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2022**

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our topic 'Who Were the Ancient Greeks and What Did They Do For Us?' for next half term, Year 4 are planning to visit the Yorkshire Sculpture Park on Thursday, 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2022.

During the day, children will take part in an exciting artist-led tour of the park to see all the exciting sculptures as well as drawing and making activities. Following this, in the afternoon children will take part in an outdoor sculpture building session.

Children should come to school at the usual time of 8.40am and will return to school before the end of the school day. Normal school uniform should be worn. The duration of the day will be spent outside so please ensure your child is wearing appropriate footwear, layers and a warm waterproof coat. The children will also require a packed lunch and a drink (*no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please*).

The cost of this visit will be **£16.90** per child. This payment contribution will go towards the cost of the coach and admission into the park and workshops. Payment can only be made via ParentPay, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. If you wish for your child to take part, please ensure payment is made by **Monday, 24<sup>th</sup> October 2022**.

Please ensure you have completed the online form which gives your child consent to attend all Exceptional Experiences 2022/2023.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits.
