

## Y6 VISIT TO THE HOLOCAUST CENTRE & MUSEUM Tuesday, 28th February 2023

Dear Parents/Carers

Next term we will be studying World War 1 and 2. To complement this topic, we have chosen to take the children to the Holocaust Centre & Museum, on Tuesday, 28<sup>th</sup> February 2023. Whilst there, they will take part in an exhibition, which tells the stories of Jewish children who lived during the Second World War and survived. They will also take part in a workshop promoting writing, as well as listening to a survivor's story. Previously, this has been a really informative and memorable trip providing a great learning experience.

We will be leaving school at 9.00 am and returning to school before our normal finish time. Children must wear school uniform. Please send your child with a packed lunch and a drink (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided for them, but if you would prefer to provide your own meal, please advise school.

The cost of this visit will be £15.68 per pupil. This payment contribution will go towards the cost of the coach and admission into the centre/museum. Payment can only be made via ParentPay, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. If you wish your child to attend, please ensure payment is made by 24<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.

Please ensure you have completed the online form which gives your child consent to attend all Exceptional Experiences 2022/2023.
