When we return to school and commence our autumn term, we are excited to be able to offer our children the opportunity to experience a visit to The Crucible Theatre, to a performance organised by the Children's Bookshow. The Children's Bookshow is a charity that inspires school children with a love of reading through an annual programme of in-theatre performances with the very best authors from around the world. Satoshi Kitamura, author and illustrator, will be coming all the way from Japan to delight and inspire children, doing lots of live drawings and sharing his imaginative stories. We will be reading Satoshi's book 'Stone Age Boy' at the beginning of the term, and pupils will receive a free copy of the book at this event.

The visit will take place during the school day. Please provide your child with a packed lunch/drink (no fizzy drinks/glass bottles), and we ask that all children are dressed in full school uniform, please.

The cost of this visit will be **£16.32** per pupil. Payment contribution will go towards the cost of the coach and performance tickets. Payment should be made via the ParentPay facility, the deadline for payment is **Friday, 29 September 2023**. If you have any difficulties accessing your ParentPay account, please contact school reception who will be happy to help. If you are facing financial hardship and are unable to make the payment, please contact the school office to discuss options in which we may be able to offer support.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
