

FIRE!

This half-term we will be working on our topic called 'FIRE'.

The children are going to learn about significant events in the past such as 'The Great Fire of London'. They will also be working on celebrations that we have now when we look at bonfire night and we will talk about our senses and what we notice. We will also be looking at how fire is used in narrative story texts.

English

We will be talking about what we can see around bonfire night. We will also be learning about 'The Great Fire of London' and a man called Samuel Pepys who wrote a secret diary about what happened. We will be producing our own narratives with characters linked to fire such as dragons!

Computing

We will be doing basic word processing and learning simple computing skills.

R.E.

We will be learning about different celebrations, how they differ and how they are similar.

P.E.

We will be focussing on ball skills in games such as netball as well as how we can keep ourselves fit.

Music

We will be learning about our voice and how we can change it by pitch or tempo.

The Arts

For art, we will do bonfire pictures. We will design and make models of Tudor houses. We will also be looking at making our Christmas calendars and cards!

Science

This half-term we will continue looking at materials. We will be looking at which materials are best for different jobs and how we can describe some of their properties.

History/Geography

In History, we will be learning about 'The Great Fire of London' and Samuel Pepys who write a diary of what happened. We will continue to look at seasonal changes in the weather.

Maths

We will be covering more about number and place value. We will further our work on addition and subtraction and how we can apply these to real life situations. We will look at naming 2D and 3D shapes and starting to discuss their properties.
