This half-term we will be working on our topic called 'Moon Zoom!' The children are going to take the role of investigators into a crash that has occurred on the school site. We will also be learning about significant people and events linked to space.

English

We will be writing reports of what has happened for our local newspaper. We will be creating questions to ask witnesses and lists of how to support others with their writing. We will also be writing labels, captions and poems all about what we have seen and heard!

Science

This half-term we will be learning about our bodies and naming different parts. We are going to recognise each of the five senses and how we use them.

We will be looking at who Neil Armstrong was and why he was famous. We will also be looking at where we live, our school grounds and surrounding areas.
