

The World at War

Reading

We will be reading a selection of non-fiction extracts this half term as well as reading extracts from novels/stories linked to WW1. We will also be reading and analysing famous war poems such as Dulce et decorum est and Who's up for the game?

Writing

Our writing this term will be around our World at War topic. We will cover several writing styles including poetry, formal letters from the War Office, informal letters home from the trenches from a soldier's perspective

Science

This term we will cover the Y6 science objectives for light. We will look at how light travels, reflection, and refraction as well as how we see within this topic.

Maths

- Fractions – applying the four operations, worded problems and finding fractions of an amount.
- Decimals – order and compare, applying the four operations, multiply and divide by up to 1000, use decimals in context.
- Order and compare decimals and fractions.
- Convert decimals into fractions and fractions into decimals.
- Percentages – understanding percentages, compare and order fractions, decimals, and percentages, finding the percentage of an amount.
