

People who help us

Our topic in Bumblebees class this half term is people who help us! First, we will be learning about doctors and how they help us to stay healthy and make us feel better when we are poorly. We will also be learning about firefighters and police officers and how they keep us safe.

Maths

In maths we will be learning to...

- Develop fast recognition of up to 3 objects, without having to count them individually ('subitising').
- Recite numbers past 5.
- Say one number for each item in order: 1,2,3,4,5.
- Show 'finger numbers' up to 5.
- Link numerals and amounts: for example, showing the right number of objects to match the numeral, up to 5.

Literacy

In literacy we will be developing our phonological awareness, so that we can:

- spot and suggest rhymes.
- count or clap syllables in a word.
- recognise words with the same initial sound, such as money and mother.

Our core texts this half term are...



Physical Development

- Continue to develop our movement, balancing, riding (scooters, trikes and bikes) and ball skills.
- Go up steps and stairs, or climb up apparatus, using alternate feet.
- Skip, hop, stand on one leg and hold a pose for a game like musical statues.
- Use large-muscle movements to wave flags and streamers, paint and make marks.

Communication and language

- Sing a large repertoire of songs.
- Know many rhymes, be able to talk about familiar books, and be able to tell a long story.
- Enjoy listening to longer stories and can remember much of what happens.
- Pay attention to more than one thing at a time.
- Use a wider range of vocabulary.
