Maths

We will be focusing mainly on number and place value this term - the building blocks in maths. We will be using this understanding to develop mental methods of addition and subtraction before moving on to more forma methods.

Alongside developing arithmetic skills, we will be given opportunities to apply our learning into problem solving.

English

This term we will be reading and studying the book 'Stone Age Boy'. This story follows a boy who falls and wakes up in the Stone Age. He meets a girl called Om who teaches him how to live like a 'Stone Age Boy'. We will also be writing instructions, a biography as well as writing opportunities in our history lessons.

The 'Iron Man' will be the second class novel, showing how the world reacts to crises and how determination and resilience will win out in the end. We will focus on story writing and creating

Design and Technology We will begin by designing Stone Age jewellery by studying artefacts and techniques from the period. We will later design and create our own holiday themed fridge magnets for sale at the Christmas Fayre.

Geography
