English

This half term the children are going to take on the role of investigators examining evidence of a rocket crash on school grounds!

We will be learning about significant people and events linked to space. Of course we are also looking forward to the Spacedome visit to our school!

History/Geography

As Historians we will learn about Neil Armstrong and why he was famous.

As Geographers we will be looking at where we live, our school grounds and surrounding areas.

Maths

In Maths we will continue learning about multiplication and division. The children will also be introduced to time learning how to recognise and tell the time to O'Clock and half past. We will also begin learning about money and being able to identify and understand the value of different coins.

DT

In DT we will design a vehicle that can travel around the moon. We will look at how we can use moving parts in our designs.

Computing

In ICT we will carry out research using the internet and learn how to create a video story to retell the events of the moon landing.

Science

In Science we will learn about animals including humans and naming different body parts and how they relate to our senses. We will learn about the basic needs of animals and describe and compare them.

Music

As musicians we will learn about Tempo and Dynamics in different pieces of music and in songs.

RE

In RE we will continue learning about Judaism and about Moses as a key figure in religious stories.
