

Reception – Summer 1

Jungle Fever

Communication & Language

Children will ask questions and demonstrate their understanding about the jungle and savanna. They will perform a poem in front of an audience in assembly.

Personal, Emotional and Social Development

Children will set and work towards their own goals. Playing and learning with their peers co-operatively. They will show sensitivity towards the needs of their peers, themselves and their environment.

Maths

In number, children will add and subtract numbers, reading and writing the calculations. They will build numbers beyond 10, understanding the number patterns and sequence. They will continue to learn what a double is and begin to recognise odd and even numbers. For shape, children will match, rotate and manipulate 2D and 3D shapes.

Physical Development

The children will negotiate space and obstacles safely, with consideration for themselves and others. The children will access the trim trail, large climbing equipment and apparatus. They will take part in cricket sessions, learning to use equipment correctly.

Understanding the World

In Nature Explorers the children will continue to look after their environment. They will plant seeds to grow vegetables and flowers. They will learn about the importance of recycling and their role to play in it. This term the children will be baking scones, biscuits and buns for their 'Tiger Tea Party' with their grown-ups.

Literacy

Our key texts this half term are; non-fiction books tigers, snakes and crocodiles. Fiction texts; The Tiger Who Came to Tea and Rumble in the Jungle. The children will draw and label animals, write facts, create a who am I? book, write a simple 3 part story and sequence stories. Children will ensure they form letters correctly and can read their work back.

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques to make different animals. They will experiment with colour, design and texture. The children will design, make and evaluate a rain stick instrument.
