Raiders - What was life like in Anglo-Saxon and Viking times?

English

In English this half term we will be writing and performing a presentation about Bamburgh. We will also be writing non-chronological reports and narrative writing linked to our history topic, Vikings. In addition to this we will focus on a narrative poem. The book we will be studying is The 1000 year old boy.

Maths

In Maths we will be looking at:

- Decimals- recognising thousandths
- Ordering and comparing decimals
- Percentages
- Interpreting charts and line graphs
- Calculating area and perimeter

Science

We will be learning all about properties and changes of materials. Comparing and grouping everyday materials based on their properties. Know that materials will dissolve in a liquid and how to get the substance from the solution. How to separate mixtures through filtering, sieving and evaporation. Investigate reversible and irreversible changes within materials.

PHSE

In PSHE we will be continuing with the unit world of drugs and looking at ESafety.

History/Geography

In History we will be looking at the Viking and Anglo-Saxon struggle for the kingdom of England to the time of Edward the Confessor.

We will focus on:

- Viking raids and invasion
- Resistance by Alfred the Great
- Further Viking invasions and Danegeld
- Anglo-Saxon laws and justice

In Geography we will be completing fieldwork at Bamburgh and looking at our findings when we return to school.

RE

In RE we will be looking the importance of Mosques in Islam.

Computing

In IT we will be using Adobe spark to produce a video presentation about Bamburgh that we will present to Y4

Art

In art this half term, we will be focusing on the artist Kittie Jones and we will be producing landscapes in a similar style.
