The National Holocaust Centre and Museum

On Wednesday 12 March 2025, students in year 6 will be visiting The National Holocaust Centre and Museum. The visit links to our history topic after Christmas which is WW1 and WW2. Whilst on the visit, the children will take part in an exhibition, which tells the stories of Jewish children who lived during the Second World War and survived. They will also listen to a survivor's story which is age appropriate. We have run the trip for many years, and it has always provided an informative and memorable learning experience.

We will be leaving school at 9:00am and returning to school before our normal finish time. Children must wear school uniform. Please send your child with a packed lunch and a drink (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided for them, but if you would prefer to provide your own meal, please advise school.

If your child would like to take part in the visit, please give consent via ParentPay.

The total cost for this visit is £18.68 per child, which is payable by ParentPay only, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. In order for us to secure the visit, it is important that we receive a £2.00 deposit by Friday 15 November 2024.

While we fully appreciate that all contributions are voluntary, we are only able to offer experiences such as this if we receive sufficient support. If you are struggling to pay for the event, please come in and discuss this with us.
