Y3 Yorkshire Museum Visit

On 2 October 2025 we will be visiting The Yorkshire Museum as a part of our Stone Age topic. We will be exploring pre-historic galleries as well as getting hands on with real artefacts from the Stone Age period.

Your child will need to arrive at school at the **earlier time of 7:40am** with the coach departing from school at 8:00am. Please ensure your child is here for registration on time for a swift departure. We will return for school at the later time of 4:30pm.

The total cost of the visit is **£17.98**. Payment can only be made via ParentPay. If you wish your child to attend, please ensure payment is made as soon as possible to secure your child's place. Please complete this [medical information form](#) to give your child permission to attend.

Children are required to wear their school uniform. It is essential that they bring a warm waterproof coat and wear sensible footwear. Please ensure **your child brings a packed lunch with them**. If your child is entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided for them, but if you would prefer to provide your own meal, please advise school.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contribution is received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
