*Will Gold Medal Hunters see their dreams come true?*

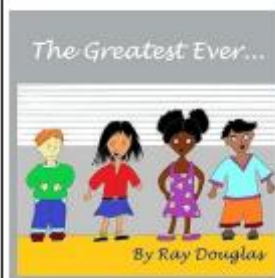


*There's an Egg in the Garden*
