Remote Learning – Parent/Child Expectations

At Maltby Lilly Hall Academy, we are passionate about your child receiving only the very best education throughout the current Covid-19 crisis to maintain their learning and always achieving their potential.

As previously communicated, during the current lockdown or when needing to self-isolate, your child will be attending lessons online with their teacher on Microsoft Teams. In these lessons we will have the same high expectations that we have of them in school. This document sets out our expectations of your child and what we need you to help us with for this process run smoothly. For our younger pupils, we would ask that parents help their children understand what they need to do to make the session work well.

- Depending on your device, you might need to download the Microsoft Teams App before the first session – if you are in doubt contact the technical support email at ma-ict@maltbyacademy.com if needed
- Test the device before the lesson. Check that the equipment that your child will be using is ready for the live lesson. Make sure that sound is working on the device that your child will be using.
- Pupils should attend every live lesson where possible. The remote learning timetable is set each week, which teachers will communicate through the Purple Mash email – this will contain a link to the live lesson. Lesson materials and links will also be shared through Purple Mash.
- At the start of the session the device camera must be off, and the microphone muted when your child logs on – their username should always reflect your child's name. This is for safeguarding reasons and to ensure the lesson runs as smoothly as possible; It makes sure no background noise impacts on the learning. The child's name should preferably be their first name followed by their initial – for example '**Ruby P**'.





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- Children should not have a profile picture on their account. Again, this is for safeguarding reasons.
- You may need to assist your child during the session with the equipment, particularly helping them mute/unmute or turn the camera on/off if needed, especially with younger children.
- Please make sure that your child understands/has read any instructions sent by the teacher before the lesson so that they have everything they need with them.
- The live lesson will probably link into your child's learning for the rest of the day – this will need to be submitted via Purple Mash or sent through Purple Mash email. Teachers will give clear instructions about how they want work to be submitted.
- All children are expected to engage with lessons as outstanding learners. They are expected to complete their learning with 100% effort, showing the strong learning behaviours we expect in school and following the instructions as well as they possibly can.
- Children should only use the chat facility if they have a question for the teacher.
- Teachers will be following the normal in-school behaviour system, and your child will be removed from the live lesson if they receive a red card - you will then be contacted directly.
- All absences will be recorded, and you will be contacted if your child does not attend sessions for two consecutive days.

We will be doing our best to put live lessons at different times so if you have several children with limited devices, they will all be able to access them – we understand that this will not always be possible and are exploring ways to record sessions and make them available afterwards – we will let you know when we are able to offer this.
