YEAR 2 VISIT TO YORKSHIRE WILDLIFE PARK - 2nd JULY 2021

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our topic work in our final half term, Year 2 are planning to visit the Yorkshire Wildlife Park on 2nd July 2021. During the day, the children will look at all the animals in the wildlife park and participate in world habitats and adaptations. Children will learn about desert, polar, savannah and rainforest habitats. **Please ensure you complete the online consent form**, **through your ParentPay, indicating if your child has any allergies with animals that may affect them participating in the activity.**

Children should come to school at the usual time, please. The coach will be leaving at 9.15 am and returning before the end of the school day. Please may we ask that children wear school uniform, have a waterproof coat and sensible shoes, but are suitably dressed for the weather on the day. A packed lunch will be provided by school unless you would prefer to send your child with a lunch from home. Please return the slip below <u>ONLY</u> if you are providing your child's lunch.

The cost of this visit will be £13.75 per child. The payment contribution will go towards the cost of the coach, admission into the park and a workshop. Payment can only be made by ParentPay, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. If you wish for your child to take part please ensure payment is made by Friday, 18th June 2021. By payment you are consenting to attendance, and in case of an emergency, the permission for your child to receive medical treatment and also confirming that your child has no allergies that we need to be aware of. Please ensure the school has your up to date contact numbers and any medical information we may require.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
