### **Key Stage 2 Outcomes 2016**

#### ***Test Outcomes***

##### **Reading**

70% of the cohort achieved the standard in Reading (40/57 pupils).

52% of boys achieved the standard in Reading (14/27 pupils).

87% of girls achieved the standard in Reading (26/30 pupils).

Girls outperform boys by 35%

##### **Mathematics**

56% of the cohort achieved the standard in Mathematics (32/57 pupils).

52% of boys achieved the standard in Mathematics (14/27 pupils).

60% of girls achieved the standard in Mathematics (18/30 pupils).

Girls outperform boys by 8%

##### **Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling**

61% of the cohort achieved the standard in GPS (35/57 pupils).

41% of boys achieved the standard in GPS (11/27 pupils).

80% of girls achieved the standard in GPS (24/30 pupils).

Girls outperform boys by 39%.

## ***Scaled Scores***

The average scaled score for the cohort in Reading is 103.1.

The average scaled score for boys in Reading is 99.8 which is 6.3 below girls at 106.1

The average scaled score for the cohort in Mathematics is 100.8

The average scaled score for boys in Maths is 100.4 which is 0.8 below girls at 101.2

The average scaled score for the cohort in GPS is 101.8

The average scaled score for Boys in GPS is 98.7 which is 5.9 below girls at 104.6

The average scaled score for the cohort in all three subjects is 101.7

## ***Teacher Assessment***

### **Reading**

96.5% of the cohort achieved the standard in Reading (55/57 pupils).

96.3% of boys achieved the standard in Reading (26/27 pupils).

96.6% of girls achieved the standard in Reading (29/30 pupils).

Girls outperform boys by 0.3%

### **Writing**

74% of the cohort achieved the standard in writing (44/57 pupils).

0% of the cohort achieved the 'Greater Depth' standard in Writing (0/57 pupils).

48% of boys achieved the standard in Writing (13/27 pupils).

97% of girls achieved the standard in Writing (29/30 pupils).

Girls outperform boys by 49%

## **Mathematics**

81% of the cohort achieved the standard in Mathematics (46/57 pupils).

78% of Boys achieved the standard in Mathematics (21/27 pupils).

83% of girls achieved the standard in Mathematics (25/30 pupils).

Girls outperform boys by 5%.

## **Science**

79% of the cohort achieved the standard in science (45/57 pupils).

70% of boys achieved the standard in science (19/27 pupils).

87% of girls achieved the standard in science (26/30 pupils).

Girls outperforming boys by 17%

## **Progress**

### **Reading**

The progress score for the cohort in reading is -2.88

### **Writing**

The progress score for the cohort in writing is -3.84

## **Mathematics**

The progress score for the cohort in mathematics is -5.1

## **National**

51% of the cohort achieved the standard in reading, writing and mathematics which is below National (53%) by 2% (29/57 pupils).

70% of the cohort achieved the standard in Reading which is above national (66%) by 4% (40/57 pupils).

74% of the cohort achieved the standard in Writing which is on National (74%) (42/57 pupils)

56% of the cohort achieved the standard in Mathematics which is below national (70%) by 14% (32/57 pupils).

61% of the cohort achieved the standard in GPS which is below national (72%) by 11% (35/57 pupils).

The average scaled score in Reading is 103.1 which is above the national average (102.6) by 0.5.

The average scaled score in Mathematics is 100.8 which is below the national average (103.00) by 2.2.

The average scaled score in GPS is 101.8 which is below the National average (104.00) by 2.2.
