**YEAR 4 VISIT TO THE DEEP
FRIDAY, 11TH FEBRUARY 2022**

Dear Parent/Carer

As part of our topic work next half-term, we are planning to take Year 4 to visit The Deep on Friday, 11th February 2022. During the day, the children will have the opportunity to participate in a workshop called 'Our Worlds Plastic Problem', as well as taking a tour of the center, viewing and learning about a range of sea creatures.

The coach will be leaving at 9.00 a.m. and will be returning to school at approximately 3.45p.m. Can we ask that children are in school by 8.30, leaving enough time to be registered and to allow chance for the toilet. Normal school uniform should be worn with comfortable shoes or trainers, please, and a warm coat. The children will also require a packed lunch and a drink (*no glass bottles or fizzy drinks please*). If your child is entitled to a Free School Meal, a packed lunch will be provided for them, but please let us know if you do not require this.

The cost of this visit will be £14.00 per child. This payment contribution will go towards the cost of the coach and admission into The Deep. Payment can only be made via ParentPay, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. When making your payment, please complete the consent section through the ParentPay item. In order for us to make sure the visit can go ahead it is important that we receive payment by 3rd January 2022.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experiences, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavor to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
