YEAR 1 VISIT TO YORKSHIRE WILDLIFE PARK – 16th JUNE 2022

Dear Parents/Carers

As part of our topic work in our final half term, Year 1 are planning to visit the Yorkshire Wildlife Park on 16th June 2022. During the day, the children will look at all the animals in the wildlife park observing and identifying how the animals are different from one another and discussing each animal's habitat and how they differ.

Children should come to school at the usual time, please. The coach will be leaving at 9.30 am and returning before the end of the school day. Please may we ask that children wear school uniform, have a waterproof coat and sensible shoes, but please ensure they are suitably dressed for the weather on the day. A packed lunch will be provided by school unless you would prefer to send your child with a lunch from home. The cost of this visit will be £14.00 per pupil. The payment contribution will go towards the cost of the coach and admission into the park. Payment can only be made by ParentPay, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. If you wish for your child to take part please ensure payment is made **by Friday, 13th May 2022**. By payment you are consenting to attendance, and in case of an emergency, the permission for your child to receive medical treatment. Please ensure the school has your up to date contact numbers and any medical information we may require, including whether your child has any animal allergies that we need to be aware of, when completing the consent through ParentPay.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. Such visits can only take place if parents are willing to contribute towards their cost. We hope that you will be able to offer your support in our endeavour to offer broad educational experiences through visits. Parents are not obliged to contribute but if insufficient voluntary contributions are received then the visit will not be allowed to go ahead.
