YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL The NST tour to London 12th June to 14th June 2023

Dear Y6 Parent/Carer

We are really excited for our upcoming residential trip to London and are now able to give further details regarding the visit.

Itinerary

On Monday 12th June, we ask that children arrive at school at the earlier time of 7:30am. Children are to make their way to the small hall via the courtyard to drop bags and medical items off. Children will then go to class to be registered before departure. We aim to depart school at 8:00am from Cliff Hill Entrance, if parents would like to wave us off!

Packed lunches will be required on the day of travel (Monday 12th) along with a couple of drinks (no glass bottles or fizzy pop) and additional snacks, if required, as we will not eat our evening meal until arrival at Jungle Cave at approximately 5:00pm. Please avoid foods with obvious nut content.

A detailed itinerary of the trip is attached on an additional document.

On Wednesday 14th June, we aim to arrive back at school for 5:00pm. However, we will communicate with parents on the day regarding this as it is subject to change.

Rooms

Children have now all selected up to three children they will be comfortable sharing a room with. Rooms at the Premier Inn are twin or triple rooms with adults situated on the same corridor near the exit routes. Children will be in an all-girls/ all-boys room and will be guaranteed to be with at least one person from their list. Children will be told their room allocation upon arrival in London.

Packing List

Children will need to pack comfortable clothing and footwear (trainers ideally) for the residential as we will be doing a lot of walking and will be out for the whole day once we leave school/the Premier Inn. Your child's belongings need to be in one suitcase. Your child is responsible for carrying their own case.





Other items needed:

- Raincoat/ Jacket
- Sun cream/ hat
- Rucksack (to be carried during the day/ hold packed lunches)
- Water bottle that can be refilled
- Nightwear (pajamas etc.)

Please note children do not need to bring bedding or towels as the hotel provides these.

We would appreciate additional sweets/snacks not being packed as they cannot eat these on the coach or in their rooms. All meals apart from the initial packed lunch will be provided and school will take some additional suitable snacks for the children if needed.

Pocket money - the **maximum** amount the children are allowed is £10. Please note this is the maximum, you can send less but please do not send more. All pocket money needs to be handed into school the week before in a labelled envelope. The money will be kept by the staff until we visit the souvenir shop as this will be the only opportunity to spend their pocket money.

Under no circumstances are mobile phones, ipods, handheld games allowed. Any items found will be confiscated and returned to the parents at school.

Medical information

Thank you for completing the medical form that has been sent out. Although we know most medical needs already, if your child takes medication before/after school this will need to be detailed so we can administer during the trip. If your child suffers with travel sickness, please send them on Monday having had a tablet or medication and hand in to us another tablet for us to administer before the journey home.

Please ensure all medication is clearly labelled and handed in to members of staff in the small hall on the Monday we depart.
