Dear Parents and Carers

Y6 visit to the Holocaust Centre & Museum

This term we are studying World War 1 and 2. To complement this topic, we have chosen to take the children to the Holocaust Centre & Museum, on Tuesday, 12 March 2024. Whilst there, they will take part in an exhibition, which tells the stories of Jewish children who lived during the Second World War and survived. They will also take part in a workshop promoting writing, as well as listening to a survivor's story. Previously, this has been a really informative and memorable trip providing a great learning experience.

We will be leaving school at 9:00am and returning to school before our normal finish time. Children must wear school uniform. Please send your child with a packed lunch and a drink (no glass bottles please). If your child is entitled to a free school meal a packed lunch will be provided for them, but if you would prefer to provide your own meal, please advise school.

The total cost for this visit is £15.42 per child, which is payable by ParentPay only, either online through the ParentPay website or at your local PayPoint. In order for us to secure the event, it is important that we receive payment by Friday 1 March 2024.

We believe that children learn best from first-hand experience, so school visits are an important part of the school year and make a positive contribution to children's development. While we fully appreciate that all contributions are voluntary, we are only able to offer experiences such as this if we receive sufficient support. If you are struggling to pay for the event, please come in and discuss this with us.
