Year 6 Planned Exceptional Experiences

At Maltby Lilly Hall Academy, we strive to ensure that whilst with us, your child will experience high quality education and engage in a curriculum which is inspiring.

Our updated curriculum intent states:

***“Engage learners through a wide range of first-hand opportunities for learning and guaranteed enrichment experiences within and beyond the school day.
Help to raise children’s levels of resilience, aspiration and ambition through the range and scope of learning experiences and a relentlessly positive ethos”.***

In Year 6 we have several visits which link to the topics we study and personal development. Our visit to Crucial Crew in September links to PHSE and is ran by the South Yorkshire Fire & Rescue free of charge. Linking to our Autumn term topics – South America and The Maya Civilization – we have an immersive VR headset experience. In Spring term, we study WW1 and WW2 and have a free in-school visit from the library service who bring many artefacts to share with the children. To further supplement our study of WW2, we visit The Holocaust Centre, which is a fantastic trip year on year that, at an age-appropriate level, explores the treatment of Jewish people during WW2 through the eyes of a 10-year-old boy. Our residential to London is an exceptional experience which involves sightseeing around our capital city, visiting national museums and watching an award-winning West End Show. More details about the residential will be shared at a meeting in September. Finally, we end the year with a trip to Walesby Forest – a day which is great fun and allows the children to be adventurous, take risks and develop teamwork skills whilst trying many different activities like kayaking, paddle boarding and climbing.
